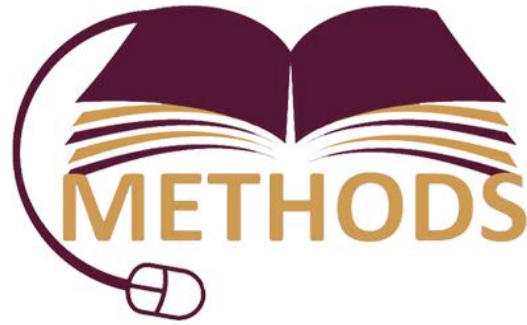


PROJECT OUTCOMES

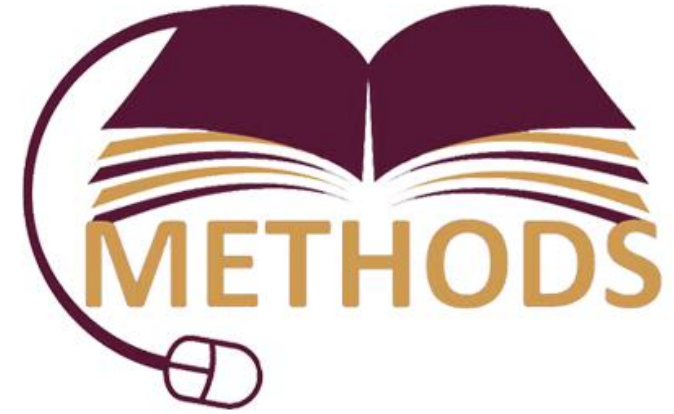
